Suggested Themes

 - d. Practice

Types of Submissions

Embracing this multidisciplinary space, the editorial board encourages a diversity of publication types to include:

Research Papers: 3,000 to 5,000 words

Articles and Essays: 1,500 to 2,500 words

Legislative Comments: 2,000 to 3,000 words

Book Reviews: 1,000 to 2,000 words
