# Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment

### APPLYING FOR VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION AND **EMPLOYMENT BENEFITS**

#### **CHAPTER 31**

Chapter 31 Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment (VR&E) is a program for disabled veterans. THIS IS NOT THE G.I. BILL and NOT an educational benefit program. Education costs may be part of rehabilitation and training for employment. The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) pays full tuition, fees, books and in many cases, parking costs to the school. In addition, the student gets a monthly stipend depending on training status. The veteran must work with VR&E caseworker for eligibility information.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Active duty service members are eligible if:

■ The service member expects to receive an honorable discharge upon separation from active duty.

- They obtain a memorandum rating of 20% or more from the VA, and
- Apply for VR&E services.

#### **VETERANS ARE ELIGIBLE IF THEY:**

- Have received, or will receive, a discharge that is other than dishonorable.
- Have a service-connected disability rating of at least 10%, or a memorandum rating of 20% or more from the VA.
- Apply for VR&E services.


#### **BASIC PERIOD OF ELIGIBILITY**

The basic period of eligibility in which VR&E services may be used is 12 years from the latter of the following:

- Date of separation from active military service, or
- Date the veteran was first notified by the VA of a service-connected disability rating.


The basic period of eligibility may be extended if a Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor (VRC) determines that a veteran has a Serious Employment Handicap.
