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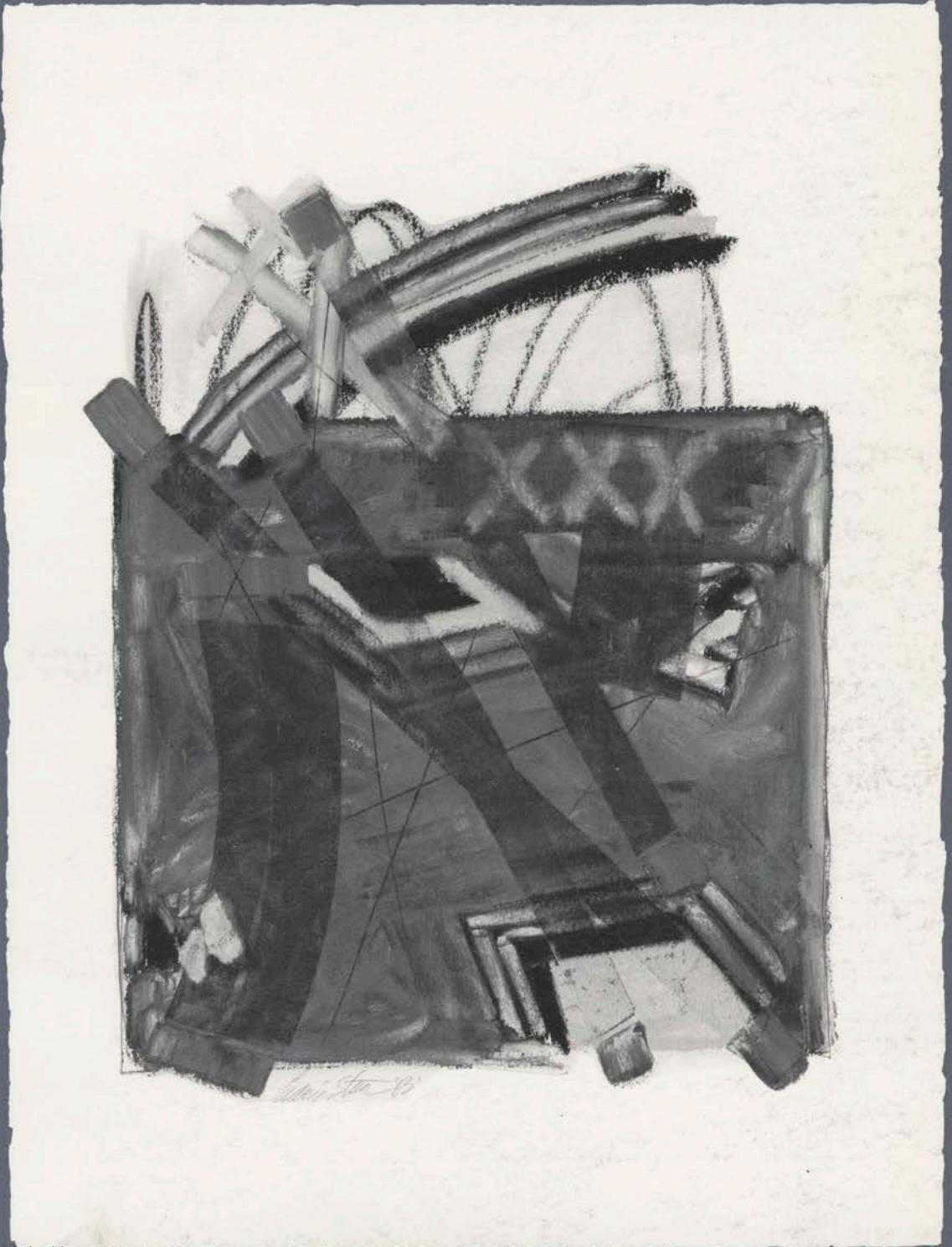
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Syracuse Scholar

Art submissions (including photography) should be unpublished work intended for the print medium. Whenever possible, reproduction will be made directly from the original art.
