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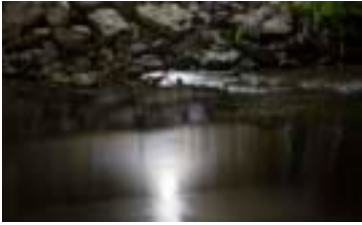
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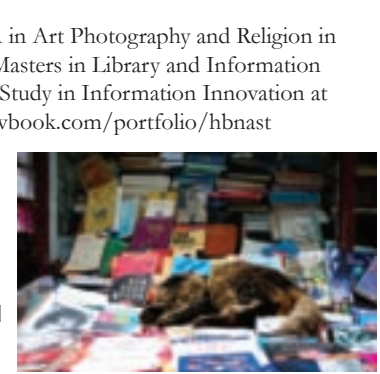
We would like to thank the artists whose work appears in this issue. Below are the original images that appear in this year's *Intertext* along with some information about the artists.
