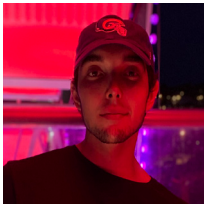

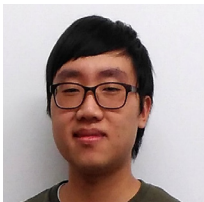
**Brandon Belton** | Writing & Rhetoric

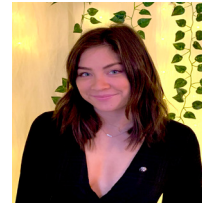
**Sydney Guyton** | English & Textual Studies
