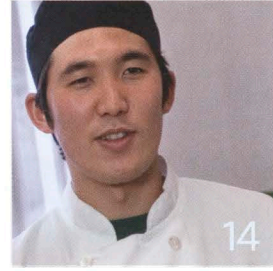
David J. Kahn '63 is known for his quirky cross-word puzzles, so take a shot at solving one he created for alumni.
