This body was organized 21 June, 1887. In the published By-laws of the University (1890) appears the following (Art. VII, Sec. 3): "There shall be a University Senate which shall consist of the Chancellor, the Deans of the several colleges, two professors from the College of Liberal Arts, one professor from each of the other colleges and two members of the board of trustees.
